

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

EAST SUFFOLK COUNCIL (PART OF FOOTPATH NO 22 HOLLESLEY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

On 26 November 2019 East Suffolk Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that part of Hollesley Public Footpath No 22 commencing from the U3711 road (Melton Road) at Ordnance Survey grid reference (OSGR) TM35744570 and proceeding in a northerly direction for approximately 44 metres to OSGR TM35744575 to a new line commencing from the U3711 road (Melton Road) at OSGR TM35734571 and proceeding in a north north easterly direction for approximately 35 metres along a track with the north north western edge of the footpath commencing 2 metres from the site boundary to OSGR TM35744575 as described in the order and as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map may be obtained or may be seen free of charge at East Suffolk Council Customer Services Centre, Woodbridge Library, New Street, Woodbridge, IP12 1DT between the hours of 8:45am and 5:00pm Monday to Wednesday, 9:30am and 5:00pm Thursday and 8:45am and 5:00pm Friday. The order comes into force on 19 February 2020 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 4 December 2019, make an application to the High Court.

This order is made by East Suffolk Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Shire Homes (Anglia) Ltd has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of the order, and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

Suffolk County Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act and has consented to the making of the order.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Hollesley and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and on the Definitive Map and described in part 1 of the schedule to this order shall be stopped up with effect from the date on which Suffolk County Council certifies that the work to bring the new site of the footpath described in paragraph 2 of this order into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out. Certification shall not take place prior to the creation of the new route described in paragraph 2 of this order.
2. There shall at the end of 84 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Hollesley described in part 2 of the schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order.

Description of Site of Existing Path


Hollesley Public Footpath No 22(part) – The entire width of that part of Hollesley Public Footpath No 22 commencing from the U3711 road (Melton Road) at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM35744570 at point A and proceeding in a northerly direction for approximately 44 metres to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM35744575 at point B; this being the route shown between points A – B on the order map.

Part 2

Description of Site of New Path

Hollesley Public Footpath No 22(part) – Commencing from the U3711 road (Melton Road) at Ordnance Survey grid reference TM35734571 at point C and proceeding in a north north easterly direction for approximately 35 metres along a track with the north north western edge of the footpath commencing 2 metres from the site boundary to Ordnance Survey grid reference TM35744575 at point B; this being the route shown between points C – B on the order map.

Width: 2 metres
