

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

MID SUFFOLK DISTRICT COUNCIL (STOWLANGTOFT FOOTPATH NO 3(PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

On 22 October 2020 Mid Suffolk District Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that part of Stowlangtoft Footpath No 3 at Highfield House, Kiln Lane commencing at Ordnance Survey grid reference (OSGR) TL95896951 and proceeding in an easterly direction for approximately 32 metres to OSGR TL95926951 then in an east north easterly and then south easterly direction for approximately 76 metres to join the U5937 road (Kiln Lane) at OSGR TL95996950 to a new line running from OSGR TL95896951 and proceeding in a southerly direction along a track for approximately 24 metres to OSGR TL95896949 then along the track in an east south easterly and then south easterly direction for approximately 101 metres to OSGR TL95966942 then along the track in an easterly direction for approximately 11 metres to join Kiln Lane at OSGR TL95976942 as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force on 22 January 2021 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 29 October 2020, make an application to the High Court.
