

## Ipswich Railway Station Improvements 20 February – 30 April 2017

Works at Ipswich Railway Station forecourt are improving accessibility for pedestrians and cyclists, buses and taxis. The new layout will be safer for pedestrians, and improve traffic flow with new short-stay and drop-off parking for car drivers.

**Planned start date:** Monday 20 February 2017  
**Expected duration:** 10 weeks

This phase of work includes Suffolk Highways replacing traffic lights, road markings and crossings outside the station, new street lighting, new bus and taxi shelters and the paving and resurfacing of the forecourt.

National Grid will also be carrying out essential gas main works along Ranelagh Road. We have worked with National Grid to do these works at the same time to minimise disruption and avoid additional road closures.


### Details of road closures

#### 20 February to 9 April 2017 (7 weeks) – 24 hour road closure:

**Ranelagh Road will be closed from the junction of Burrell Road to Ancaster Road.** This includes works to replace traffic lights, street lighting and for National Grid to carry out gas main works.

Access will be available from the Ancaster Road junction for residents and businesses only. Businesses will remain open.

20 February to 9 April Ranelagh Road – 24 hour closure




#### 10 April to 13 April 2017 – 24 hour road closure:

**Right turn lane eastbound only, junction of Ranelagh Road into Ancaster Road.**

This is for National Grid to carry out gas main work.

10 to 13 April 2017 – Right turn lane only, 24 hour closure



#### Tuesday 18 April to Friday 21 April and Sunday 23 April to Sunday 30 April 2017 OVERNIGHT CLOSURES 9pm to 5am including weekends:

**Princes Street** – between Burrell Road and Commercial Road,  
**Ranelagh Road** – between Burrell Road and Ancaster Road,  
**Burrell Road** – between Princes Street and Willoughby Road.

The road will be closed from 9pm to 5am to reinstate, remove and replace the road markings. Access for residents and businesses will be managed on site by gatemen at the closure points. The road will be open from 5am to 9pm daily.

## Additional works

### Ipswich Station Forecourt Resurfacing – 4 day 24 hour closure - dates to be confirmed

The railway station forecourt will need to be closed for the resurfacing of the taxi and bus lanes. Access will still be available for pedestrians throughout the closure. Temporary bus stops will be provided, taxis will be relocated to the drop off point and these will be clearly signposted on site.

### Summer 2017 – Anglian Water works - dates to be confirmed

Anglian Water is planning water main works in the Ipswich Station area in summer 2017 and the dates of these works are to be confirmed.

Suffolk Highways will return to the site following the completion of the Anglian Water works to resurface the road later in the year. Resurfacing of the road will take place during overnight closures. More information will be available at [www.roadworks.org](http://www.roadworks.org) once the dates are confirmed.

We will do our best to minimise inconvenience to customers during these works.

**Access to the station will be available at all times.** Staff on site will be able to answer any questions and help you if you need any assistance.

**Access for emergency services will be available at all times.**

**Bus and taxi services will be available throughout.** There will be signs to the temporary bus stops and taxi pick up locations while the works are in progress. **Car parking and drop off** signs on site will point you to the correct location for car parking.
