Health and Care Academies

- Academies in West Suffolk, Ipswich, Colchester and Tendring
- Currently delivered virtually via MS Teams
- Choice of a bespoke package delivered students aged 14 – 18 to give an insight into careers and career pathways available
- Or signpost to our openly advertised Academies during school holidays or weekends
- Ambassadors deliver a short presentation to students about their role followed by a Q&A session
- Can include practical skills such as BLS, infection prevention etc. as well as CV writing and Interview skills and personal statement advice

E-Work Experience Portal

- Portal is hosted by Lincolnshire Talent Academy, managed and supported by the Next Generation project
- Students need to register with the Portal before they can access the opportunities
- If students don't meet the criteria, for example age, their application won't be accepted
- 'Let's Talk About' sessions
- Offered as 1:1 or small group of maximum 5 young people
- Aim is to enable participants to ask more in-depth questions and find out more about the job role
- Currently delivered virtually via Microsoft Teams
