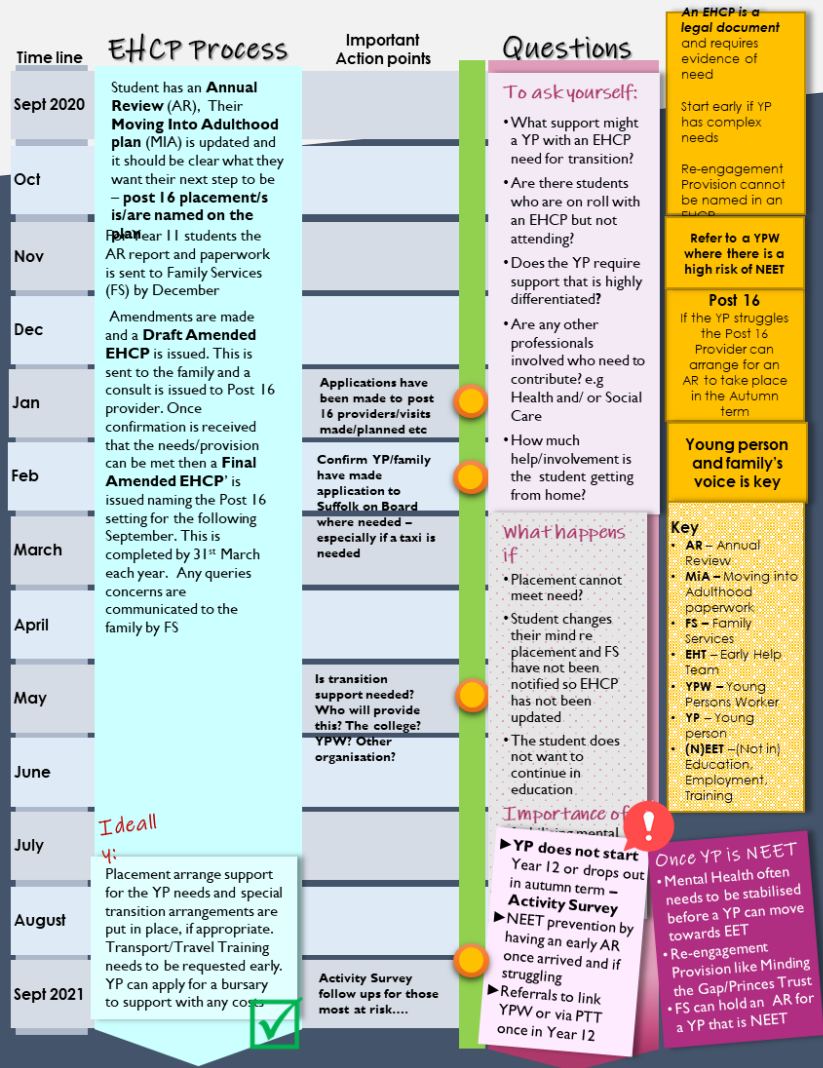

Timeline and tips

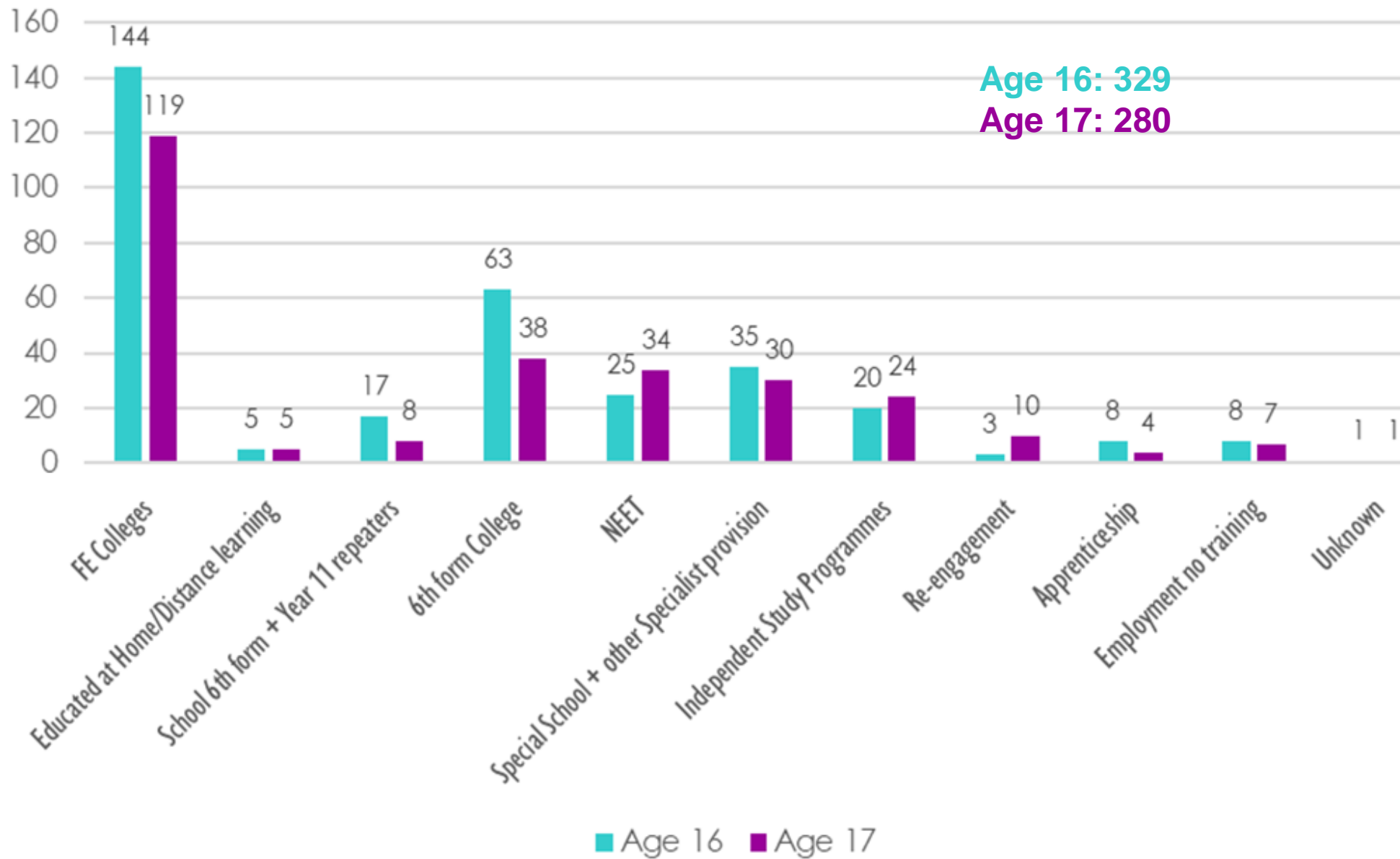


Once YP is NEET
