Respond to requests from PTT to resolve anomalies re who is in your school</p>	<p>a) <b>2<sup>nd</sup> Nov – 20th Nov 2020</b></p>
3	<p><b>September Offer:</b></p> <p>All young people are entitled to an offer of learning in Year 11 (and 12). This reporting captures which post 16 education and training organisations &amp; employers have made an offer to a young person and also what plans or situation a young person is in if they cannot access learning eg if they are ill/pregnant etc. This reporting is also used to highlight where contact/support needs to be targeted before the start of Year 12 (13)</p>	<p>a) Confirm (before students start their exams) with PTT what definite plans and offers <b>all</b> students on roll have</p>	<p>a) <del>Between beginning of March to the Easter Holiday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021</del></p>
